**\*NOTE TO PLANNING OFFICER – CAROL ANN O’KANE.**

Whilst Hurley Parish Council objects to this application, it was agreed during discussion of the application, that a number of measures could be taken to alleviate the concerns raised in the Parish Council’s grounds for objecting. The Parish Council would therefore suggest that the applicant considers taking the following actions:

1. Remove the platform on which the outbuilding rests.
2. Consider relocation of the outbuilding away from the boundary
3. Plant a natural screening
4. Move the security lighting
