<b>HONEY LANE FARM,</b> Honey Lane, Hurley	16/01753	Mr N Evans	Single storey rear extension.
<b>HURLEY RIVERSIDE PARK,</b> High Street, Hurley	16/01952	Hurley Riverside Park Ltd	Works to Trees in Conservation Area. T5 - Lime reduce crown. T1-T7 and T9 and T11 - Limes crown reduce by 1-2m all over, estimated height after pruning 28m with size of pruning cuts being 50mm. T8 and T10 – Limes fell to ground level due to excessive shading.
<b>7 BAINHURST COTTAGES,</b> Coronation Road, Littlewick Green	16/02038	Mr M and Mrs L Peacock	Single storey rear extension, ground floor front bay window, rear dormer and 3 x front roof lights to facilitate loft conversion.
<b>12 BELL COURT,</b> Hurley	16/02046	Mrs E R Roberts	Works to Trees in Conservation Area. 9 Sycamore trees T1 – reduce to their original points. Silver birch T2 – pollard/ Magnolia T3 – crown lift and reduce in height. Was done last in 2009. Estimated height of trees after reduction 2m-3m.
<b>KNOWL HILL CE PRIMARY SCHOOL,</b> Bath Road, Knowl Hill	16/02047	Isabel Cooke	Construction of a detached modular classroom building.
<b>MANOR LODGE,</b> High Street, Hurley	16/02136	Ms J Smith	Ground and first floor rear extensions with alterations to existing roof.
