WHITE HOUSE , Star Lane, Knowl Hill.	17/01432	Mr and Mrs D Murray	Two storey side/rear extension following demolition of the existing garage.
CHURCH HOUSE , High Street, Hurley	17/01523	Mrs Caroline Stanford	Works to trees in a Conservation Area. T1 Chestnut – raise canopy to 8m.
THE OLD BAKERY , Burchetts Green Road, Burchetts Green	17/01553	Mr and Mrs Harrington	Reinstatement of railings to the existing low wall at the front of the property. Reinstatement of gates to property. Listed building consent (17/00350) has already been granted for this proposal.
SHEPHERDS COTTAGE , Jubilee Road, Littlewick Green	17/01632	Mr Orasio	Works to trees in a Conservation Area. T1 Prunus cerasifera – reduce height by 4m and crown lift by 1m.
Windsor Cottage , High Street, Hurley.	17/01652	Mrs Lynne Graham	Works to trees in a Conservation Area. T1 remove two conifers. T2 unknown tree – fell. T3 Five conifers – fell.
