<b>THE DOWER HOUSE,</b> Hall Place Lane, Burchetts Green	18/00470	Mr Rice	Works to Trees in Conservation Area. Works as per the Tree Inspection Report (FDA0538) Oct 2017
<b>SUNGEI LALU,</b> Frogmill, Hurley	18/00443	Mrs Helps	First floor side extension, pitched gable fronted garage roof and alterations to fenestration.
<b>LAND OPPOSITE THE ENTRANCE TO TOKAI,</b> Hatch Gate Lane, Cockpole Green	18/00587	Mr John Kersley	Works to trees covered by a TPO. T1 and T2 Fell possible dead trees (TPO4 of 1951).
