TYTHECOTE MANOR, High Street, Hurley	18/00755	Lord Howard Leigh	LBC - Consent for alterations to roofs and repairs to chimneys.
FURZE COTTAGE, Burchetts Green Lane, Burchetts Green	18/00951	Mr Paul Johnson	Conservation Area Trees – T1 Various species unknown – reduction to 2/2.5 metres.
20 HONEY LANE, Hurley	18/01060	Mr Leigh	New front porch and part single part two storey side and rear extension.
LEE END, High Street, Hurley	18/01073	Mr Cripps	Conservation Area Trees T1 and T2 Lime – Fell.
WARREN HOUSE, 3 Lovelace Close, Hurley	18/01083	Mr Kragg	Conservation Area Trees T1 – 7 conifers – fell. T2 – Cedar, Magnolia, Malus – tip reduce the lower canopies and crown lift. Trees will be lifted to 3.5m from ground level by tip lifting only. T3 – Conifers – fell. T4 – Beech – Fell.
